Re: Maintenance Work on the Jolly Harbour Channel

Permission has been granted by the Antigua Port Authority and the Development Control Authority to carry out maintenance work on the channel at Jolly Harbour, from the Fairway buoy, positioned at 17.04.05.N, 61.54.07 W, to the first red and green channel marker within Jolly Harbour.

Please be advised that this maintenance procedure, which includes sweeping of the channel, is expected to begin on March 25th, 2013, with an estimated time of completion of 8 weeks.

A large dredge will be working in the channel, and a dredge pipe will be located on the North side of the channel leading to the deposit site on Pearn's Point.

The location of the pipe will be marked with 12inch diameter red buoys at intervals of 50ft above water and 200ft when the pipe is on the sea bed.

At night, the dredge will be lit to international navigational standards and will be located on the north side of the channel.

While the sweeping operation is in progress, there will be times when access to the channel may be limited. In this case an alternative access to the south of the channel will be marked with red and green buoys. The depth will average 8ft, and navigators are asked to proceed with extreme caution.

While work is in progress, navigators should NOT PASS OR ANCHOR to the North of the channel, and are urged to proceed with caution in the vicinity of the works.
